Kindergarten Registration Week - October 13-16, 2015

These children have the option of starting Kindergarten the following year. If you have a child entering Kindergarten next year, visit the main office between 8:30 am-3:00 pm to have him or her registered. **Proof of immunization, birth certificate and Medicare cards** are required at the time of registration. It is important that your child be registered at this time in order to receive information needed for pre-school screening and successful transition into school for September 2016.
