## “Ring Ring” Cellphone Policy:

Students may use their cellphones from :

- Arrival time until 8:30
- Snack time 10: 37 to 10:52
- Lunch time 11:54 to 1:44
- After 3:00

**Offences:**

- First offence - students phone is sent to the office and parents must pick up
- Second offence— students phone is kept in the office for a week or a one day suspension
- Third offence—students phone is kept in the office for two weeks or a two day suspension

As the offences increase, so does the number of weeks or days or suspension.

## Dress Code for Middle School

- Hats may be worn before 8:30, as students proceed outside during their lunch hour and after the hours of 3:00. Hats may not be worn during class time, only if it is hat day.
- No muscle shirts with the arms holes cut low
- No inappropriate messages on shirts
- No showing of underwear
- Bras or bandeaus should not be seen under shirts (front or back)
- Shorts/Skirts should be an appropriate length (pockets should not be longer than shorts, no rips, students should not have to pull them down to sit down)
- No headbands
- Shirts should meet students pants (no bellies showing)
