Parents/Guests - You will be asked to complete a self-assessment questionnaire posted at the entrance of the building as outlined above. There will be a hand sanitizing station at the main entrance. The grad and his/her guests will wait in the open area by Office. Social distancing is to be followed. Parents and students are not required to wear a mask if physical distance is maintained; however, it is strongly recommended that people wear a mask in public settings. Masks or gloves will not be available for distribution at the school.

<u>Dress</u> – Grads will be receiving their caps, gowns and sash at the school and due to the fact that this event is considered part of our formal graduation ceremony, please dress respectfully. The expectation is that guys wear dress pants, shirt, and tie. Girls can wear capris, a dress or skirt or dress pants. Shorts and jeans should not be worn.
