

What is Entrepreneurship?



Entrepreneurship:

- -is the process of creating a NEW venture
- -requiring the ability to recognize an opportunity,
- shape a goal,
- and take advantage of a situation
- Bring about change to achieve some benefit (may be financial,but may be the satisfaction of knowing you have changed something for the better)

Entrepreneurs:

-a person who creates a new venture (planning, raising resources,...)

Venture:

- -an activity that has the following characteristics
 - *A special goal
 - * Extensive planning
 - *A risk of failure
 - *Preparation by the person in charge
 - *Major commitment of time, energy and other resources
 - Ex) Business, medical-research project, school dance, fund-raiding drive, new novel, support groups

Why do we teach Entrepreneurship 110?


Entrepreneurs play a key role in the Canadian economy.
