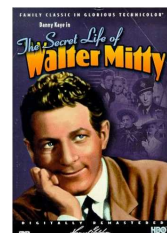


1. Figurative language plays an important role in "The Secret Life of Walter Mitty." Find three examples of figurative language in the story.
