



Unicellular and Multicellular

Cells have common characteristics. So the cell in your finger has similar characteristics to say a cell from a maple leaf.



Organisms can either be Multicellular or Unicellular.

Multicellular Organism - means they are made up of MANY cells

Ex) animal, plant and human cells

Unicellular Organisms - only have one cell

Ex) Amoeba

Ex) Pond organisms such as **Paramecium**. They obtain their own food from the environment. They are covered in short, hairlike structures called cilia that are used both for movement and to sweep food into their tiny grooves that are similar to mouths.
