

You cross the street without using the crosswalk. The police officer directing traffic at the corner notices and gives you a ticket for jaywalking. The cost to you is \$50!

Your friend's jacket sure looks good on you. Too bad somebody steals it from the back of your chair! You replace it and it costs you \$150.


