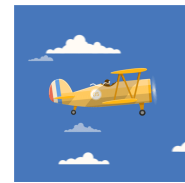




Unit 2 Flight

Air plays an important role in flying

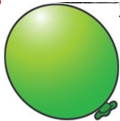
Properties of Air
