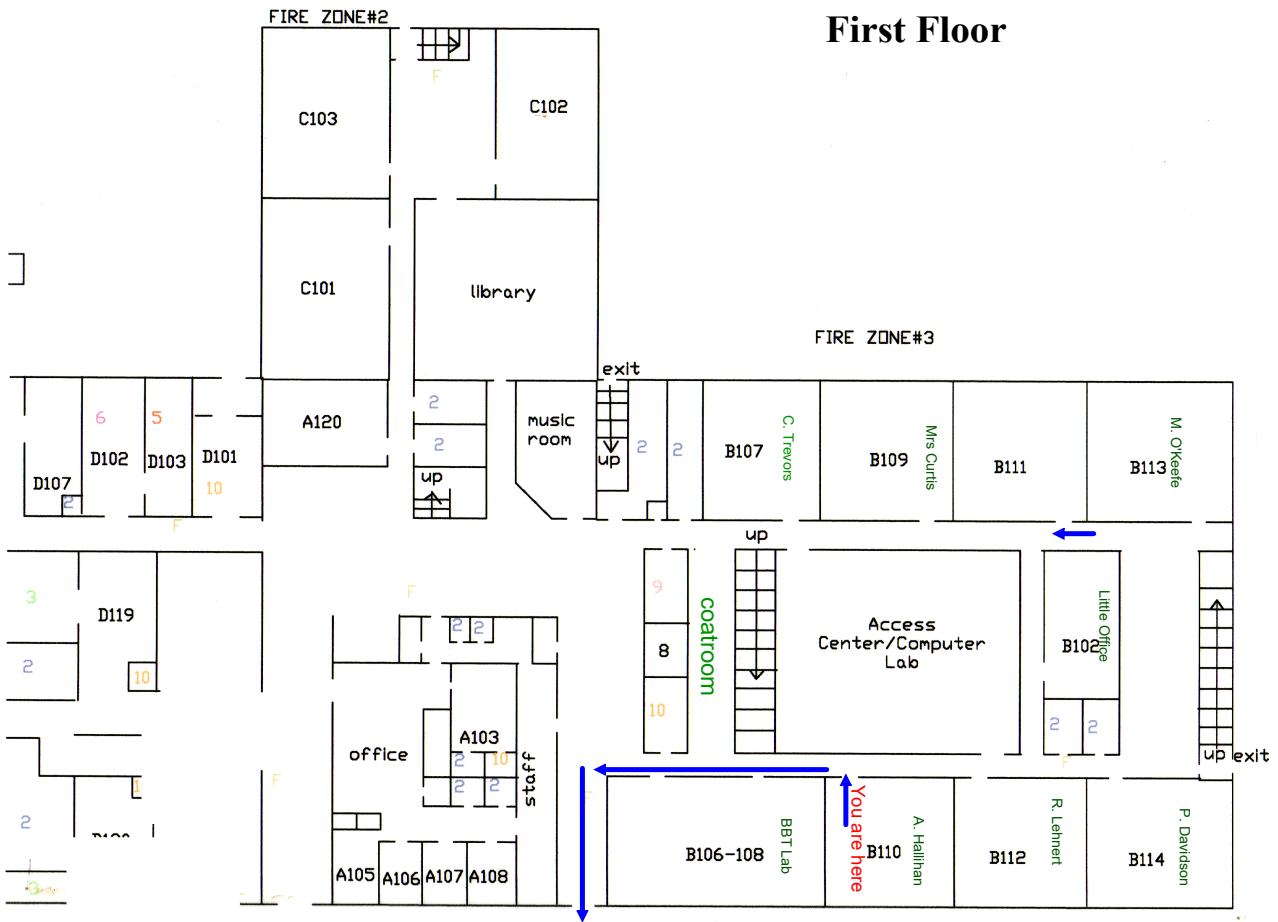
- Blackville Alumni (class of 1997)
