

Discrete vs. Continuous

For word problems

Discrete means you do not connect the dots (since you can not have part of your x variable)

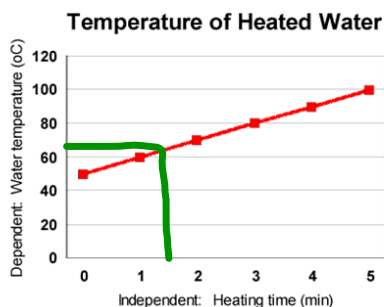
ex) Graphing how many people attended a dance. (Can't have half a person)

fix
↓

Continuous means you connect the dots (since you can ~~not~~ have part of your x variable)

ex 1) Graphing how many hours. (Can have half a hour)

The cost of making the local corn maze is \$300. Jim makes a \$5 profit for each person that joins. An equation for the relation is $P=5n-300$, where n represents the number of people attending in one week, and P represents his weekly profit in dollars.



a) Create a table of values for the relations.

Use the values n : 0, 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80

$P = 5n - 300$

Show work for

<p>$n=0$</p> $P = 5n - 300$ $= 5(0) - 300$ $= 0 - 300$ $P = -300$	<p>$n=10$</p> $P = 5n - 300$ $= 5(10) - 300$ $= 50 - 300$ $= -250$	<p>$n=20$</p> $P = 5n - 300$ $= 5(20) - 300$ $= 100 - 300$ $= -200$
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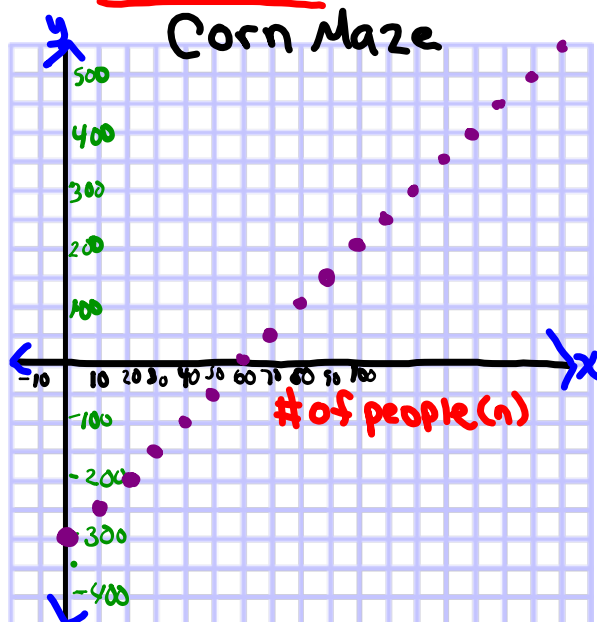

30	-150

80	100

b) Use grid paper and label the x, y axis, provide a title of a graph and axis. GRAPH the data

Don't connect Dots

→ Cannot have part of a person

Profit (\$)



c) What do negative values of P represent? Owe money
or
In the whole

d) Do we connect the dots? Why or why not?
See first page (No)

e) One week Jim had 150 people. How much profit did he make?

Show work

$$\begin{aligned}
 P &= 5n - 300 \\
 &= 5(150) - 300 \\
 &= 750 - 300 \\
 &= \$450
 \end{aligned}$$

He made \$450 profit if 150 people attend.

f) IF he made a profit of \$725, then how many people attended the corn maze.
Show work

$$\begin{aligned}
 P &= 5n - 300 \\
 \$725 &= 5n - 300 \\
 725 + 300 &= 5n - 300 + 300 \\
 1025 &= 5n
 \end{aligned}$$

$$\frac{1025}{5} = \frac{5n}{5}$$

$$\boxed{205 = n}$$

205 people must attend in order to make a profit of \$725.
