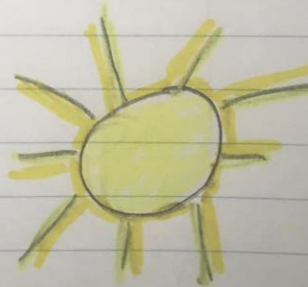
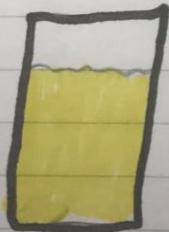


Goodbye Winter, Hello Spring
