Math Choice Board (April 27th - May 1st)

Pick 2 activities per day

Continue to review basic facts to 18 daily. If possible do Reflex Math 2-3 times per week or Splash Math

Answer the following questions about todays date:

- *What is today's date?
- *What was yesterday's date?
- *What is tomorrow's date?

Record each date from above on a piece of paper (exp: Monday, April 27th, 2020). Challenge: Ask an adult to show you other ways you can record the date (exp: 27/04/20)

Start with any day of the week and name the days of the week in order. Write the days of the week on cards and practice reading them and putting them into order. Practice starting from different days each time. Challenge: Can you write the days of the week out correctly without looking at the cards for spelling?

Use a May 2020 calendar to answer the following:

- *What will be the day and date 5 days from May 3rd?
- *What date is the second Monday of May 2020?
- *Does May have 30 or 31 days? Remember the
- "knuckle" trick we learned in class.
- *What date is Mother's Day?
- *Make up some of your own questions

Play "I Spy" using a May 2020 Calendar

Example: I spy a date that is an even number. It has two digits. It is more than 9 but less than 11. What day and date am I?

(Answer: I am Sunday, May 10th)

Start with any month of the year and name the months in order.

Pick any month and tell someone:

- 1. What month comes before that month?
- 2. What month comes after that month? Challenge: Can you write out the months of the year in order starting with January?

Print out or make a blank calendar on a piece of paper. Fill in all the information for May 2020. Add in any special dates that your family might be celebrating. Don't forget about Mother's Day on May 10th. Post the calendar on your fridge to use throughout the month of May.

Happy Birthday to Turner on May 26th

Answer the following questions:

- 1. We started grade 2 in the 9th month. What month was that?
- 2. Use an ordinal number to tell what month Christmas is in? Valentine's Day? Your birthday?
- 3. What is the 6th month?
- 4. Make up your own ordinal questions using the months of the year. January is always the 1st month of a new year.

Use a May 2020 Calendar

- 1. What will be the day and date 5 days from Victoria Day?
- 2. What date is the second Thursday in May 2020?
- 3. How many Sunday's are there in May 2020?
- 4. Is the last day of May more or less than one week away from Victoria Day? How do you know?
