

Home Learning Opportunities Week of April 20th to April 24th

Math (minimum 20 minutes daily)

Continue to review basic facts to 18 daily. If you can, try to do <u>Reflex Math 2-3 times per week.</u> You can use Splash Learn throughout the week as well.

This week, we will be reviewing **money**. Students in grade 2 need to be able to count a given sum of money using nickels and dimes. For a challenge, you can also add in some quarters.

Gather up some coins (nickels, dimes and quarters) and place them in a dish for your child to use this week. Use the activities posted each day to review counting coins.



Literacy (minimum 20 minutes daily)

Students are asked to read daily for at least 20 minutes. Students can read books at home or ones that are available online (AMIRA or Kids A-Z)

If you have any chapter books at home this would be a good time to start reading one to your child. Read 1-2 chapters per day. Ask them questions to check their level of comprehension. I am reading <u>Sarah Plain and Tall</u> to my own kids this week.

Thursday we will be doing some writing.

Social/Emotional Learning
