

## The Rock Cycle

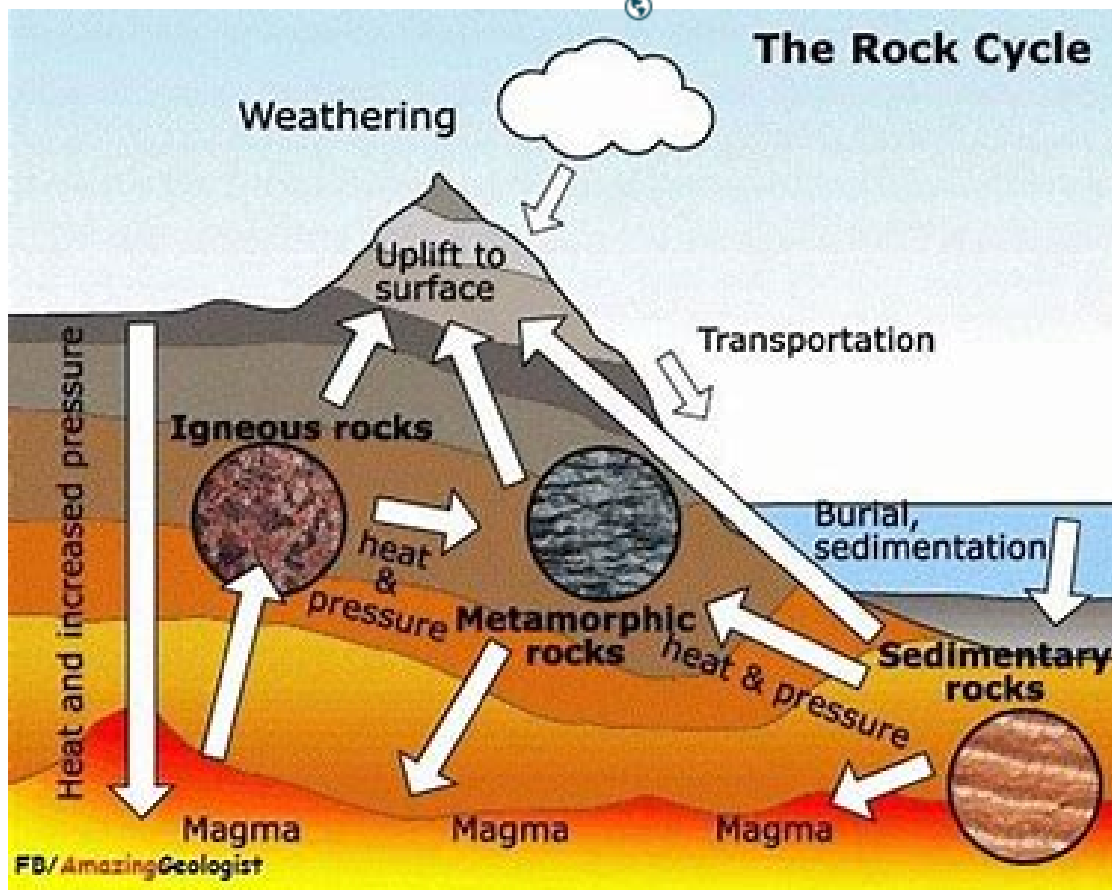

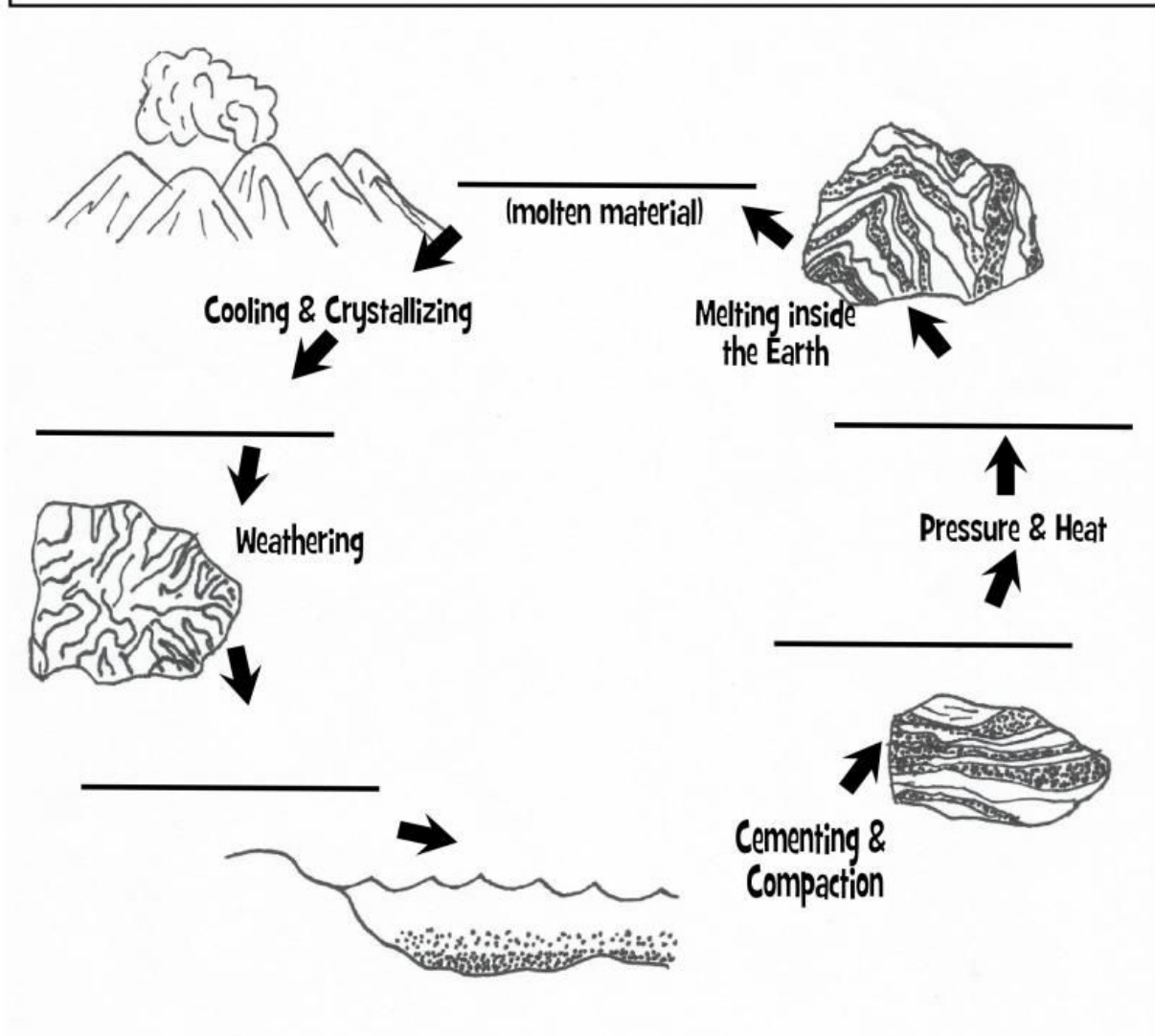

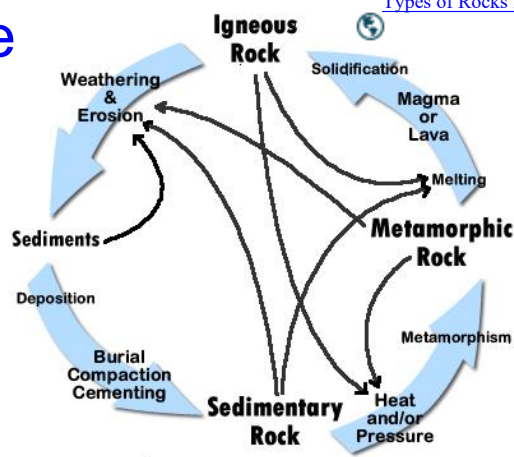


Layers of Learning
