

SENTENCES

A **sentence** is like a **train**. The words are the cars that connect and work together.

Let's look at some examples of sentences and some non-sentences.

This is a sentence: **Our safari vehicle traveled over some bumpy roads.**

This is not a sentence: **Traveled over some bumpy roads.**

This is a sentence: **The animals that live at Grammar World love children.**

This is not a sentence: **The animals that live at Grammar World.**

A **sentence** is a **group of words** that expresses a **complete thought**.

Every sentence has two parts: a **subject** and a **predicate**.

- A **subject** tells **who** or **what** the sentence is about.
- The **subject** is a **noun** or **pronoun**.

- A **predicate** tells **what** the **subject is** or **does**.
- The verb is found with the predicate.
