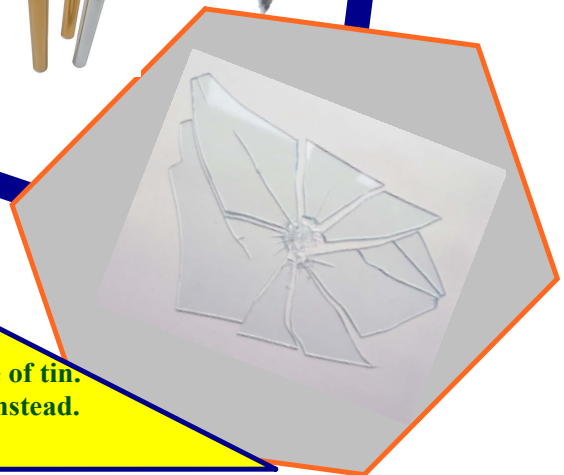
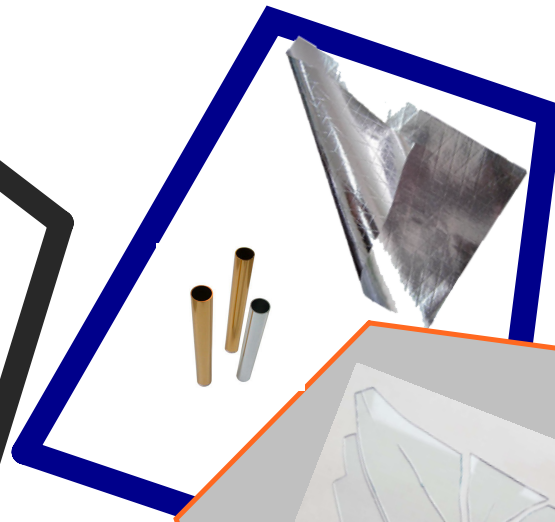


3) Malleability: ability of a substance to be hammered or bent into different shapes.
