

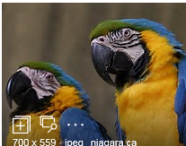
Animal Classification (Part 2)

Vertebrates continued3) Reptiles - terrestrial, but many species spend time in the water

- bony skeletons
- paired limbs (except snakes & Lizards) with clawed toes
- scale-covered skin



- cold-blooded (eco-thermal)
- Fertilization internal
- Young receive some parental care (alligators) in some species

4) Birds - Terrestrial

- hollow boned skeleton
- paired limbs with the forelimbs as wings (some are not useful flight)
- Species adapted to flight
- warm blooded (endo-thermal)
- fertilization internal

5) Mammals - Give birth to live young

- drink milk as babies
- Young are cared by parents
- born with hair or fur
- warm blooded
