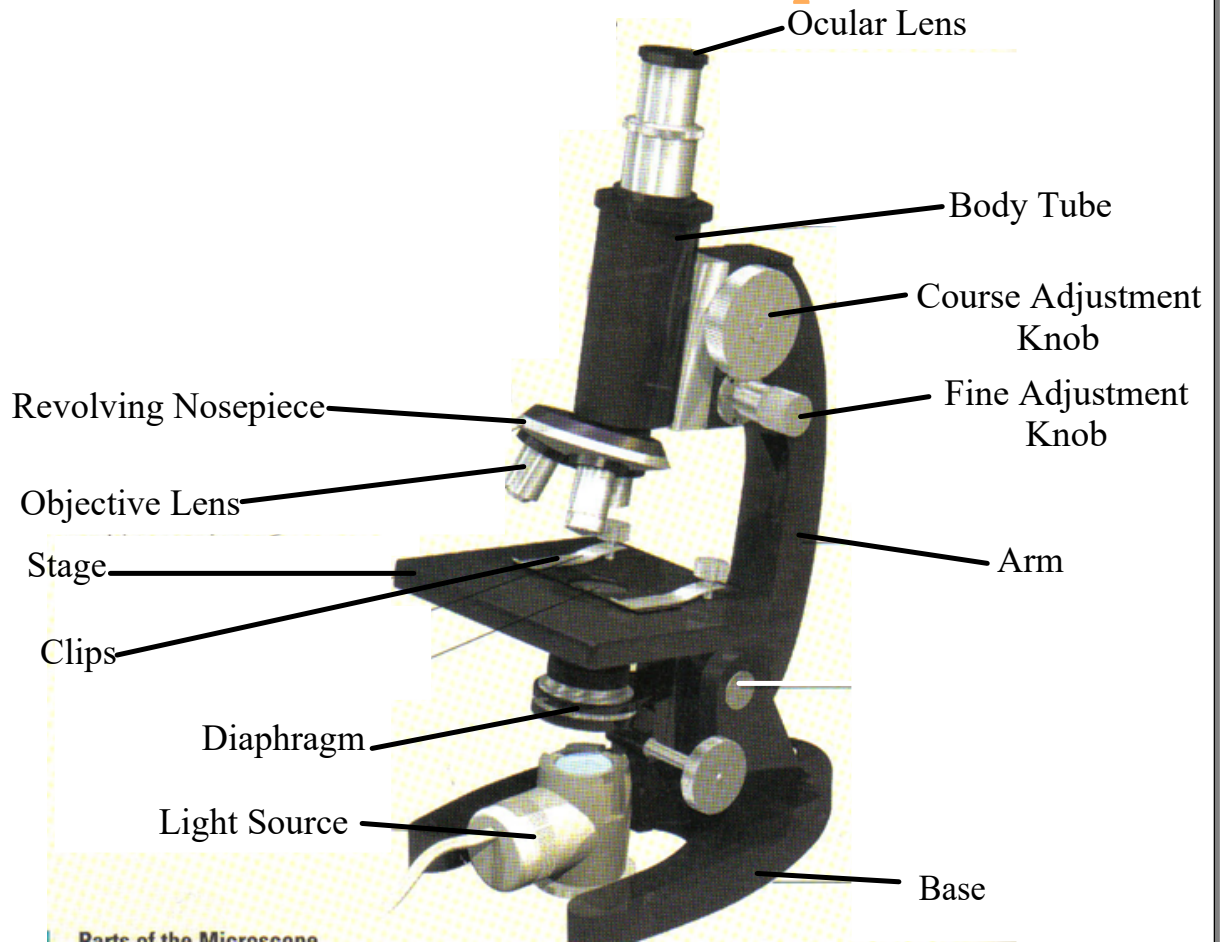

Parts of the Microscope Structure/Function Matching



1. D Where the slide is placed.




2. G Used to focus when using the low power objective.

K Magnifies the object or specimen by either 10X, 4X or 40X

4. I Supports upper parts of the microscope, used to carry microscope.

5. L Used to focus when using the high power objective.

6. E The lens you look through, also known as the eyepiece.

7. B Supports the microscope. 
8. H Used to hold the slide in place. 
9. F Opens and closes to change the amount of light reaching the object. 
10. J Rotates allowing the lens to be changed
11. A Supports the objective lenses
12. C Directs light to the object or specimen.
